Transcripts- Copies of official transcripts from every institution attended (transcripts CANNOT be downloaded from the computer).

Your social security number is used to provide identification for the processing of your application.

If there is some question as to whether you have met the prerequisite course work or have the equivalents of the prerequisite coursework from another university, you will need to submit an “Equivalency Petition” for each course you want to get approved to the Coordinator of the program for which you are applying.
