APPLICATION FILING PERIODS AND DEADLINES

Fall Semester | October 1 - July 1

Step 1 - Cal State Apply

Submit your application on Cal State Apply | <u>https://www2.calstate.edu/apply</u>

- You can use our guide to complete your application | <u>Application Guide</u>
- When creating a profile, select "No" to the question concerning the visas, then select your state of residence. The MSIDT program will not appear if you select "yes."
- Under "Academic History," make sure to select "I am not adding any standardized test scores." The MSIDT program does not require the GRE.
- Make sure to submit your personal statement and resume in the "Program Materials" section.

Step 2 - Transcripts

Send in official transcripts to the Office of Admissions. There are two options: paper or electronic (instructions can be found <u>here</u>).

Submit your official English Proficiency Exam score if all degrees were obtained outside the U.S.
