*These core 300 level classes are prerequisites to the 400 level classes.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all courses accepted for the subject matter preparation program. Demonstrated oral and written proficiency in French at ACTFL Advanced High are to be considered part of the exit-level criteria.

French 310 and 311 are acceptable in either the language or culture categories.
