B.4 Math (3 units) <b>Any course</b>	<b>**need a grade of C- or better**</b>
B.5 Implications and Explorations in Natural Sciences and Math (3 units-upper division) <b>HIST 330 or HIST 331</b> <b>(**Do NOT take yet; wait until 60 units earned)</b>	
<b>Area C. Arts and Humanities (12 units minimum)</b>	
C.1 Introduction to the Arts (3 units) <b>Any course</b>	
C.2 Introduction to the Humanities (3 units) <b>HIST 110A</b>	
Additional units in C.1 or C.2 (3 units) <b>RLST 110</b>	
C.3 Explorations in the Arts and Humanities (3 units-upper division) <b>HIST 377</b> <b>(**Do NOT take yet; wait until 60 units earned)</b>	
<b>Area D. Social Sciences (12 units minimum)</b>	
D.1 Introduction to the Social Sciences (3 units) <b>GEOG 100 &amp; ECON 201 &amp; ECON 202 &amp; HIST 110B</b>	
D.2 American History, Institutions and Values (3 units) <b>HIST 170A or AMST 201 and HIST 170B</b>	
D.3 American Government (3 units) (If AP Gov. credit is used for this area, POSC 300 is required to satisfy graduation requirements)	<b>**need a grade of C or better**</b>
D.4 Explorations in Social Sciences (3 units-upper division) <b>HIST 310, or HIST 320, or HIST 386A</b> <b>(**Do NOT take yet; wait until 60 units earned)</b>	
<b>Area E. Life Long Learning (3 units minimum) EDSC 320</b> <b>(**Do NOT take yet; wait until 60 units earned)</b> (Also meets one pre-requisite course for the credential program. Please note this course may not continue to satisfy Area E, so a different course may have to be taken here eventually.)	
<b>Overlay Z. Cultural Diversity (1 class required) Satisfied by taking HIST 110A</b>
