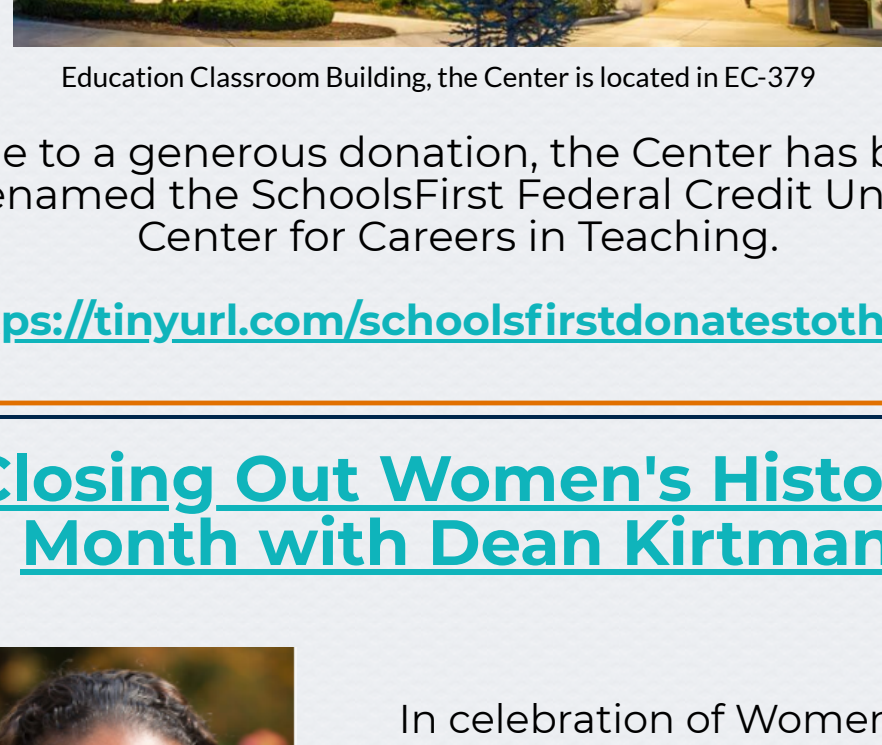

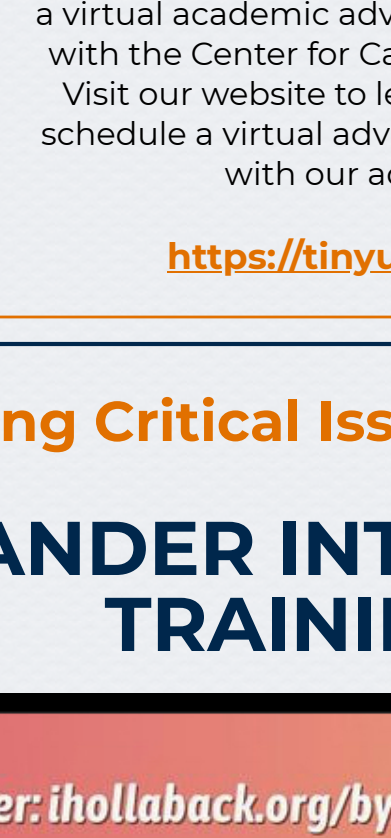

Closing Out Women's History Month with Dean Kirtman

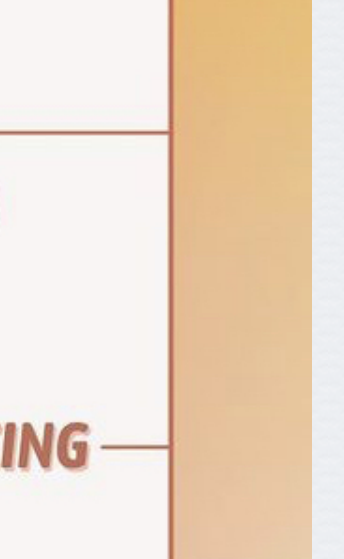


Math & Science Ambassadors Program

MSTI Scholarship for Future Science, Teachers, Science Major (\$1,000)
For CSUF Fullerton junior or senior science majors who are pursuing a career in teaching secondary science (grades 6-12).
REQUIREMENTS:

- At least a 2.75 GPA
- Completed at least two of these credential program pre-requisites: CBEST or EDSC 310, 320, 330, or 340

MSTI Scholarship for Future Science Teachers, Minor in Natural Sciences (\$1,000)
For CSUF Fullerton junior or senior minor in natural sciences who are pursuing a career in teaching secondary science (grades 6-12).
REQUIREMENTS

- At least a 2.75 GPA
- Passed MATH 380 or MATH 401/402 with a "B" or better.

MSTI Scholarship for Future Math Teachers, Mathematics Minor (\$1,000)
For CSUF Fullerton junior or senior math minors who have the intent of pursuing a career in teaching foundational-level mathematics (grades 6-10).
REQUIREMENTS

- At least a 2.75 GPA
- Passed either the CSET MATH 110 or MATH 111 content exams of MATH 130 or MATH 150A
