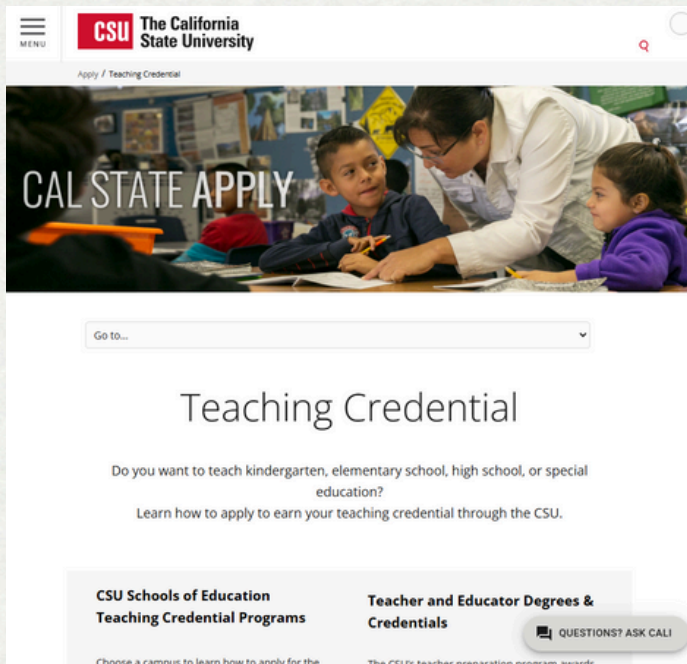

## \$3 Million Grant Prepares Bilingual Educators for 7-12 Grade Classrooms Project to Train Teachers to Teach in Spanish, Korean, Vietnamese and Mandarin

“Project ICARO is designed to embrace, value and include the linguistic repertoires of all candidates and how they leverage their skills to ensure linguistic inclusion and justice in classrooms.” -Gavin Tierney

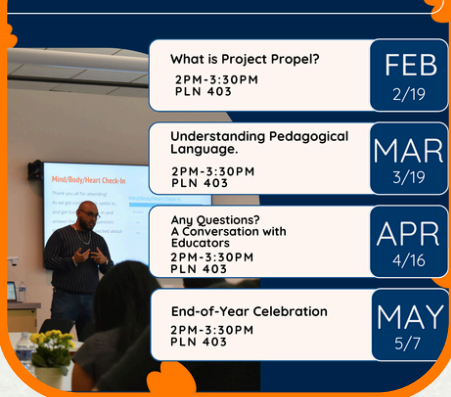
