CSUF Future Teacher Scholarship

Amount: \$2000 (multiple scholarships may be awarded)

Established by: This scholarship is funded by the College of Education to support students pursuing a credential in the College of Education at Cal State Fullerton.

Criteria:

- Applicants must have attended at least one Center for Careers in Teaching (CCT) program event per semester during their undergraduate years at CSUF. Examples of such events include Men of Color in Education, Titan Future Teachers, Project Propel, or CCT workshops (i.e. Future Educator Expo). Those who attended more than one event per semester will receive additional points in the evaluation process
- Must have met with an Advisor in the CCT at least once per semester (if this is your first semester at CSUF you may still apply as long as you have met with an advisor once this semester)
- Current or formerly enrolled student at CSUF
- Must attend CSUF College of Education Credential Program for the 2026-2027 academic year

Application Procedure:

Complete the Future Teacher Scholarship [Application](#), which includes responses to the following:

- Explain how the CCT has impacted your path to becoming a teacher. (250 words or less)
- Reflecting on detailed, personal experiences, share why you want to be a teacher **and** how you will use [Just, Equitable and Inclusive Education \(JEIE\)](#) in your work as a teacher. (500 words or less)

Application Deadline: April 24, 2026

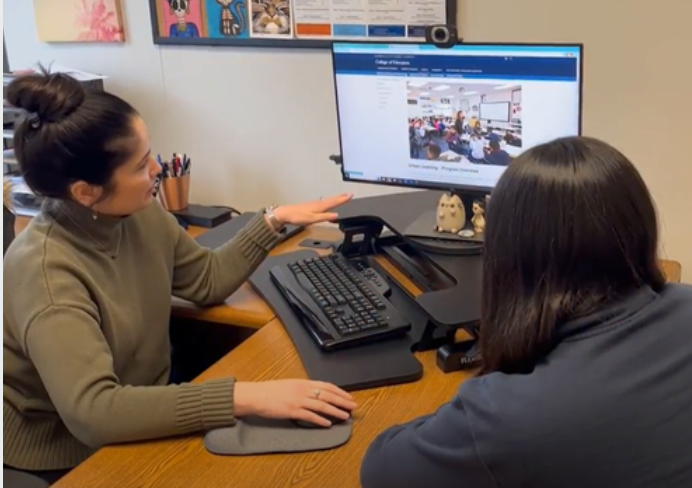
Alumni Lauded for Their Innovation and Leadership in STEM Education

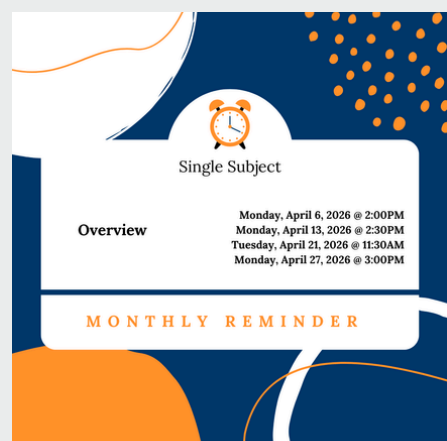
