"At-Risk" vs. "At-Promise"

Let's Talk: **Exploring Critical Issues in Education**

As of January 1st, 2020, all uses of the term at-risk in California's educational and penal codes have been changed to "at-promise." California is the first state to officially eliminate the term from the state's

codes. "One of the reasons [at-promise] is so important is because of unconscious bias and all of the things we see play out when students are

inappropriately labeled." Changing the name is one important step, but there's many other things to do as well," said Elisha Smith Arrillaga who is the Executive Director of Education Trust-West, which is a research and advocacy organization focused on California students.
