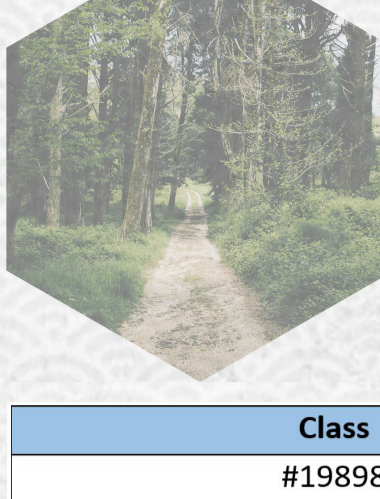

- MATH 403B

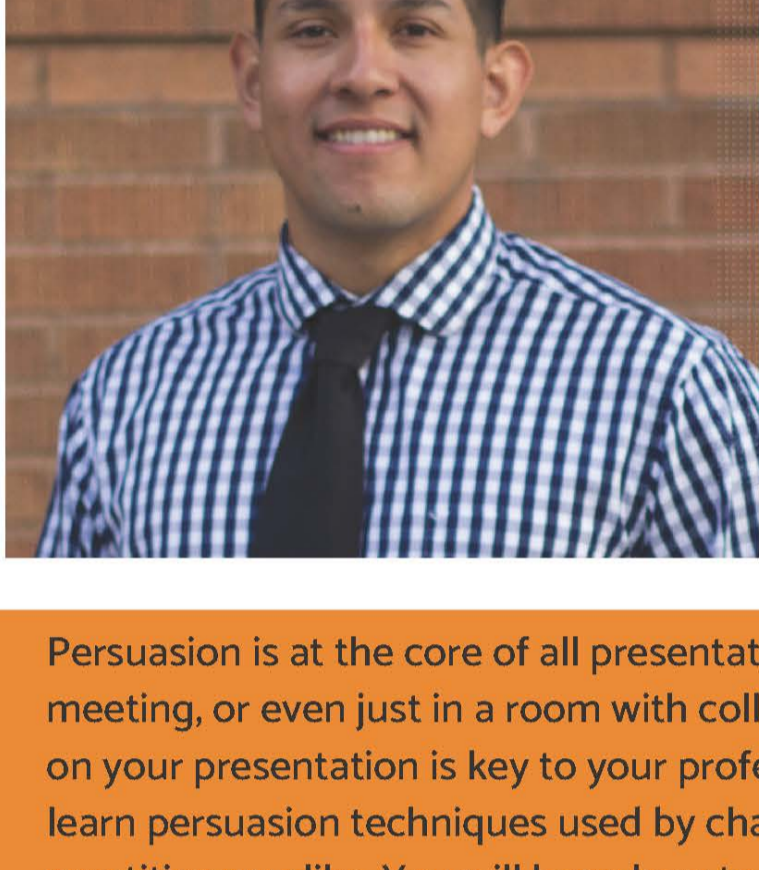
Scholarship recipients will also be given a Special Interest in Mathematics endorsement to include in your job application portfolio indicating that you received this scholarship.
