Suggested Co-Teaching Timeline for 8 Week Placement

Teacher Candidate: Week 1

Conduct daily routines (i.e., morning opening, read aloud, transitions to and from recesses, daily dismissal, etc.).

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>one</u> lesson using **One Teach, One Assist** strategy in <u>math.</u> TC supports.

Co-plan and co-teach at least **two** lessons using the **Supplemental** strategy in **language arts.** TC works with below-grade level group and contributes ideas during planning.

Teacher Candidate: Week 2

Continue to conduct daily routines.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using **One Teach**, **One Assist** strategy in <u>math</u>. TC leads instruction and contributes ideas during planning.

Co-plan and co-teach at least **two** lessons using the **Supplemental** strategy in **language arts.** TC works with higher-level group and leads planning.

Teacher Candidate: Week 3

Continue to conduct daily routines.

Take on all leadership for co-planning and instruction in <u>math</u>. Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using **Alternative and Supplemental** strategies in <u>math</u>.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using the **Parallel** strategy in <u>language arts.</u> TC shares leadership with planning.

Teacher Candidate: Week 4

Continue to conduct daily routines.

Continue leadership for co-planning and instruction in <u>math</u>. Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>one</u> lesson using the **Station Teaching** strategy.

Take on leadership for co-planning and instruction in <u>language arts</u>. Co-plan and co-teach at least **one** lesson using the **Team Teaching** strategy in <u>language arts</u>.

Mentor Teacher: Week 1

Assist with daily routines if necessary.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>one</u> lesson with TC using **One Teach, One Assist** strategy in <u>math.</u> CT leads and provides feedback.

Co-plan and co-teach at least **two** lessons using the **Supplemental** strategy in <u>language arts.</u> CT leads planning, provides feedback, and works with higher-level group.

Mentor Teacher: Week 2

Assist with daily routines if necessary.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using **One Teach, One Assist** strategy in <u>math.</u> CT supports instruction, leads planning, and provides feedback.

Co-plan and co-teach at least **two** lessons using the **Supplemental** strategy in <u>language arts.</u> CT supports planning, works with below-grade level group, and provides feedback to TC.

Mentor Teacher: Week 3

Assist with daily routines if necessary.

Co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using **Alternative** and **Supplemental** strategies in <u>math.</u> CT supports planning and provides feedback to TC.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using the **Parallel** strategy in <u>language arts.</u>
CT shares leadership with planning and provides feedback to TC.

Mentor Teacher: Week 4

Assist with daily routines if necessary. Review ST evaluation with TC to note areas for improvement.

Co-teach at least one <u>math</u> lesson using the **Station Teaching** strategy. CT supports planning and provides feedback to TC.

Co-plan and co-teach at least **one** lesson using the **Team Teaching** strategy in <u>language arts.</u> CT supports planning and provides feedback to TC.

Teacher Candidate: Week 5

Continue to conduct daily routines.

Continue leading planning and instruction in math and language arts. Co-teaching strategies should be utilized as needed to support student learning.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using the **Alternative**, **Team** or **Station Teaching** strategies in **science** or **social studies**. TC shares leadership with planning.

Teacher Candidate: Week 6

Continue to conduct daily routines.

Continue leading planning and instruction in math and language arts. Co-teaching strategies should be utilized as needed to support student learning.

Take on leadership for co-planning and instruction in science or social studies. Coplan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using the **Alternative**, **Team** or **Station Teaching**.

Teacher Candidate: Weeks 7 & 8

Assume responsibility for all classroom routines, co-planning, instruction, assessment, and classroom duties. Coteaching strategies should be utilized as needed to support student learning.

Mentor Teacher: Week 5

Assist with daily routines if necessary.

Continue to provide feedback. Provide support with <u>math</u> and <u>language arts</u> instruction and planning if necessary. *Co-teaching strategies should be utilized as needed to support student learning.*

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using the **Alternative**, **Team** or **Station Teaching** strategies in **science or social studies**. CT shares leadership with planning and provides feedback.

Mentor Teacher: Week 6

Assist with daily routines if necessary. Review ST evaluation with TC to note areas for improvement.

Continue to provide feedback. Provide support with <u>math</u> and <u>language arts</u> if necessary. Coteaching strategies should be utilized as needed to support student learning.

Co-plan and co-teach at least <u>two</u> lessons using the **Alternative**, **Team**, or **Station Teaching** strategies in **science or social studies**. Continue to provide feedback. Provide support with instruction and planning if necessary.

Mentor Teacher: Weeks 7 & 8

Continue to provide detailed, specific, and timely feedback. Use "One Teach, One Observe" strategies. Provide planning and instructional support if necessary.
