Dr. Pamela Walker served as executive vice chancellor of educational programs and services at the California Community College Chancellor's Office and oversaw divisions responsible for providing state-level technical assistance for all community college instructional and student services activities. Walker led efforts developing the bachelor's degree, integration of programs in both student services and instruction, led the task force on accreditation and was responsible for streamlining the curriculum approval process.

Walker is a highly regarded educational leader with experience as a faculty member and administrator in the K-12 system, four-year universities, and in the California Community Colleges. Prior to the Chancellor's Office, Walker served American River College where she worked for 12 years including a stint as interim president of the college. Prior to being named president, she held positions including vice president for student services, associate vice president for instruction, and dean of science and allied health. At Cerritos College she was the dean of health, physical education, recreation, athletics and dance and interim dean of admissions and records. She also held the position of associate commissioner for the California Community College Athletic Association. Walker is a tireless advocate for the benefits of education working throughout her career to develop programs of distinction to better serve students. She is passionate about mentoring the next generation of leaders and currently serves as an Education Consultant.

She received her bachelor's degree from Eastern Oregon State University in La Grande, master's degree from California State University, Sacramento, and her doctoral degree in organization and leadership from the University of San Francisco.
