Our aim is to produce enthusiastic readers and writers!

Authentic and engaging activities to build skills and confidence in reading will be provided. Students will use “passports” as they “travel” to different locations to build decoding, fluency, comprehension, vocabulary, and writing skills. Parents will be invited to attend the last session for a reading performance by the students. Space is limited, so register early!

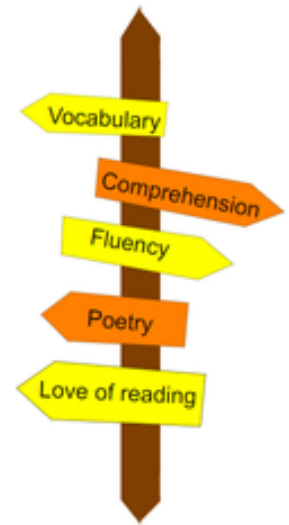

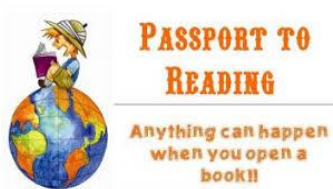
About Hazel Miller Croy Reading Center

The Hazel Miller Croy Reading Center provides a number of services to the community. One-on-one intervention and assessment services for children who need assistance in reading and literacy are provided at our center on the CSUF campus in EC 24 during semester-long sessions. Assistance with locating recommended private tutorial services is also provided. All HMC Reading Center services are coordinated by professional faculty in the Literacy and Reading Education Department.
