During this 5-day summer program students will have opportunities to practice their developing literacy skills in a group with a 6 to 1 teacher ratio (or less). Our aim is to produce enthusiastic readers and writers!

Authentic and engaging activities to build skills and confidence in reading will be provided. Students will use "passports" as they "travel" to different locations to build decoding, fluency, comprehension, vocabulary, and writing skills. Parents will be invited to attend the last session for a reading performance by the students. Space is limited, so register early!


