- A copy of your teaching credential;
- Copies of your transcripts from the college or university where you were awarded your undergraduate degree, along with transcripts from your credential granting institution;
- A current professional resume;
- A 500 word statement of purpose that outlines your interest in the MSE degree. In your statement of purpose you should address the following areas: specify if you are pursuing an emphasis in secondary education, teaching foundational mathematics, or teacher induction, provide a brief description of your current teaching situation, discuss your readiness to take online courses, and include anything else that you feel would enable the graduate committee to make an informed decision regarding your acceptance into the MSE program;
- Two or more letters of recommendation from people able to discuss your aptitude for graduate studies. The people writing your letters should speak to your teaching ability as well as to your ability to pursue graduate work in education. For example, one letter might focus on your successful teaching experience (written by a principal or department chair), while the second letter might focus on your academic abilities as a student. This letter may be written by a former professor.
- An interview is required. Raquel Clovery will contact you to schedule an interview. Prior to the interview (which *may* be conducted at a distance), students will be asked to complete *Smarter Measure*, which is a web-based tool that assesses a learner's likelihood for succeeding in an online learning program.
