ES-06-INT-EX-ES: FOR CANDIDATES ON AN INTERNSHIP CREDENTIAL WITH AN EXISTING EDUCATION SPECIALIST CREDENTIAL IN M/M OR M/S

- For advisement purposes, this plan identifies the coursework sequence for the Level I, Level II, and MSE program. Interns are not required to earn a MSE.
- MSE classes are designated in **red and with an asterisk (*)**.
- Level II classes are designated *in italics*. Candidates with a Professional Level II Education Specialist Credential have met equivalency for all Level II classes EXCEPT SPED 496 and SPED 531/532.
- Courses which may be available as WEB are identified in with a number sign (#).
- Non-CSUF course equivalencies must be documented with an approved Course Equivalency Petition or they will NOT be accepted by the Credentials Office and your credential may be delayed. The student is responsible for retaining copies of approved petitions.
- All classes in each semester should be successfully completed before advancing.
- With the exception of Semester 3, students may not register for more than two (2) 500-level classes per semester.
