

## **Education Specialist Clear Credential Program Checklist**

- To be eligible for this program:
- You must hold a Level I or Preliminary Education Specialist Credential.
- You must be employed as a full-time teacher when you take SPED 533.
- **Deadlines**: Fall- August 15<sup>th</sup>

Spring- January 15<sup>th</sup>

## Step 2: Submit Documents

## Step 3: Register for Classes

To register for classes, please choose <u>ONE</u> of the following options; apply to the university <u>OR</u> apply to Extended Ed.

- Apply to the University- You can apply to Extended Ed online through their website: <u>www.calstate.edu/apply</u>. There will be a \$55 application fee and you will need to submit official transcripts from <u>all</u> colleges and universities to Admissions & Records. *Fall deadline*: May 31<sup>st</sup>; *Spring deadline*: November 1<sup>st</sup>. Once admitted to the university, students will register for courses online through their student portal.
- Apply to Extended Ed- You can apply to Extended Ed online through their website: <u>http://extension.fullerton.edu/professionaldevelopment/edspecialist</u>. If you have questions regarding the application process, please contact the Extended Ed office directly at (657) 278-2611. Fall deadline: August 15<sup>th</sup>; Spring deadline: January 15<sup>th</sup>. Please note: Students must apply to Extended Ed each semester they plan to enroll in courses.
