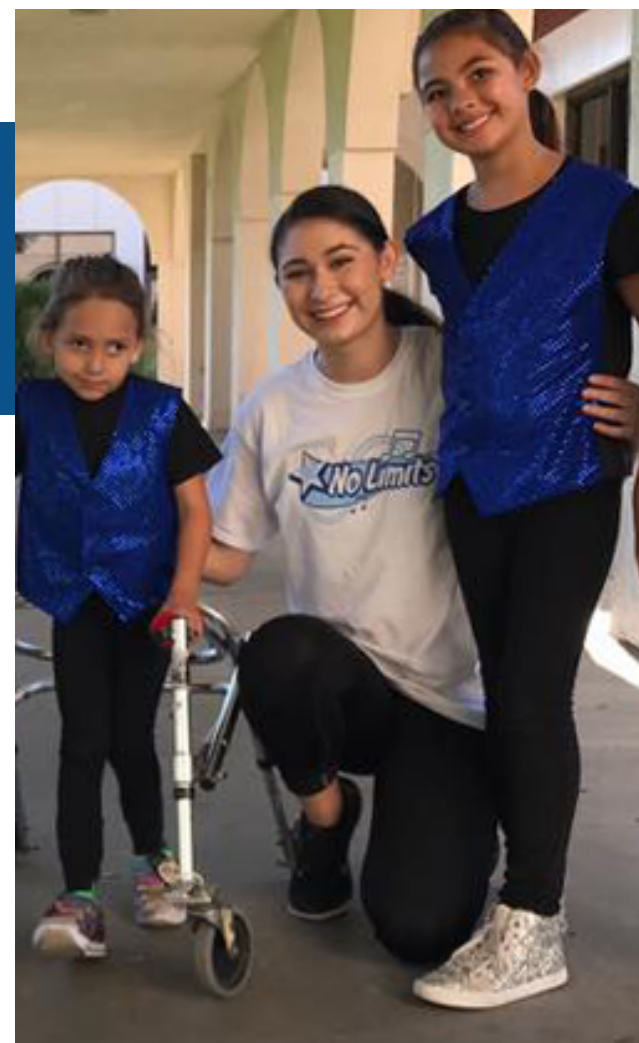
NEW! PARA-ED PATHWAY

- **Designed for you!** Uniquely designed for instructional aides/assistants/paraeducators interested in becoming fully credentialed teachers.
- *Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE):* Credential students work in preschool, TK, or K.
- *Mild to Moderate Support Needs (MMSN) & Extensive Support Needs (ESN)* Credential students may work in elementary, middle, secondary, or adult education but will need to be able to satisfy the TPE7 and TPA/LPA requirements.
- **Clinical Practice?** Complete clinical practice while working as instructional aides/assistants/ paraeducators.

FAQS

- Q: Would changes in paraeducator positions or school sites impact a candidate's ability to complete student teaching?
 - A: Yes. Please inquire with our Clinical Practice Coordinator.
- Q: Can one-on-one paraeducators complete student teaching hours during their work hours?
 - A: Unfortunately, no but let us know your situation so we can help you consider options.
- Q: Does it matter where I work?
 - A: Paraeducators must work in the program for which they are seeking credentialing.
- Q: How do I get approval?
 - A: Our Clinical Practice Coordinator can work with you, school administrators and district human resources to help seek approval.
