***CPR procedures for an individual with a physical disability***

For an instructor to pass on individual who is unable to perform all coursework required in a CPR class due to a physical disability, the person could demonstrate competency by verbally walking another person through the necessary procedures so the other person can perform CPR. If the instructor feels the individual with the physical disability is competent in the verbal walk-through and successfully completes all necessary requirements of the course, the individual with the physical disability can receive CPR certification.
